Dear Friends of Camp Mary White,

This year, as we began preparations for our 3rd summer camp session (with a thriving girls' camp and women's retreat,) the Board of Trustees decided that it was time to craft a new mission statement and a vision statement that would reflect the function of our organization that has moved past preserving Camp Mary White to now actively creating and providing programming.

One of the projects at the Board of Trustees meeting in January was to rewrite the FCMW mission statement and vision statement. When the original mission statement was developed, the primary goals of FCMW were to preserve and revitalize the camp (by repairing infrastructure, building our connections to alumni and the community, and safeguarding CMW's history and legacy.) The preservation mission statement served well to inspire the board along the journey of reopening camp.

For inspiration during the crafting process, we used a "word cloud" comprised of key words used by parents and campers during and after our summer camp session (in social media comments and end-of-camp evaluations.) The size of the individual words in the graphic is determined by how many times those words are repeated. "Experience" clearly stands out as what our community most values about Camp Mary White.

The Board of Trustees is honored to be a part of the journey toward revitalizing camp and is honored to be a part of the team that is creating and sharing the CMW experience.

2017 CAMP REPORT

2017 was a year of "firsts" since reopening Camp Mary White for girl camping!

It was the first time we had a really large number of participants. We had 61 campers. Of those campers, 8 had been to camp before, and 53 were brand new campers!

It was the first time we offered a 2-week camp session. Most of the campers registered for 1 week, but we had 11 campers stay for the whole 2 weeks. Thus, during the entire camp session, we filled 72 camper slots!

It was the first time we had substantial donations of campership funds for girls. Through a grant from a private donor for girls in Eddy County, a grant from the Community Foundation of West Texas, and donations from several members of the FCMW and the wider community, we were able to provide financial assistance to the families of 28 campers!

It was the first time we had horseback riding on CMW property. Ms. Mary's great niece, Lorraine "Shep" Vogel provided the riding program with her son Josh "Hoss" and

horse trainer David "Cowboy" acting as riding directors.

It was the first time we had campers outpost away from camp. Our 2nd session of Adventurers (9-10 graders) camped out at Turkey Springs. They practiced their camping skills and even mastered a dutch oven cobbler!

Out of all these firsts, perhaps the best of all is that it was the first time we had campers crying and hugging each other on the last night of camp . . . at the end of both sessions. When it happened, we looked at each other and said, "That's how we know the magic is working."

We know that our summer of firsts is only a beginning, and we can't wait to see the firsts that each summer brings.
